FAMILIARIZATION PROGRAMME FOR INDEPENDENT DIRECTORS

PREAMBLE

In terms of Sub Regulation 7 of Regulation 25 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure requirement regulation) Regulations 2015 stipulates on the companies that they shall Familiarize the Independent Directors with the company .

1. Industry overview and business model of the company and an outline of corporate plan and Annual targets.
2. Operations overviews.
3. Financial performance and working position of the Company.
4. Familiarization as a Board member including their roles rights and Responsibilities.

The above initiatives help the director to understand the Company, its business and the regulatory framework in which the company operates and equip him/her to effectively fulfill his role as a Director of the Company. this initial module will be restructured as and when needed.

CONTINUAL FAMILIARISATION PROGRAMME MODULES

In order to update the Independent Directors on the Business and operations of the Company, the Company shall follow a structured orientation programme as and when needed during the year.
